

ORDER N° 8/00031 /MINESUP OF 30 AOUT 2018

To launch the competitive entrance examination into **Year one of the Second cycle** of the Higher Teacher Training College (ENS), University of Yaounde I, for the 2018/2019 academic year.

**THE MINISTER OF HIGHER EDUCATION,**

- Mindful of the Constitution ;
- Mindful of Law N° 2001/005 of 16<sup>th</sup> April 2001 to set up Higher Education orientation;
- Mindful of Decree N° 88/1328 of 28<sup>th</sup> September 1988 to organise the Higher Teacher Training College;
- Mindful of Decree N° 93/026 of 19<sup>th</sup> January 1993 to set up Universities ;
- Mindful of Decree N° 93/036 of 29 January 1993 to set up administrative and academic organisation in the University of Yaounde I ;
- Mindful of Decree N° 2005/342 of 10<sup>th</sup> September 2005 to modify and to complete certain dispositions of Decree N° 93/027 of 19<sup>th</sup> January 1993 to set up general disposition for the universities ;
- Mindful of Decree 2018/190 of 02<sup>nd</sup> March 2018 to complete certain dispositions of Decree N° 2011/408 09<sup>th</sup> December 2011 to organize the government;
- Mindful of Decree N° 2018/191 of 02<sup>nd</sup> March 2018 to reshuffle the government;
- Mindful of Decree N° 2012/433 of 01<sup>st</sup> 2012 October to organize the Ministry of Higher Education ;
- Mindful of Order N° 18/00091/MINESUP/SG/DAUQ/SDEAC/SE of 22<sup>nd</sup> February 2018 to set up the calendar for competitive examinations into the Institutions of Cameroon state universities, in the course of the academic year 2018-2019 ;
- Mindful of Circular N° 004/CAB/PM of 10 February 2000 concerning the admision into national training institutions and the recruitment into the Public Service.

On the proposal of the Rector of the University of Yaounde I;

**HEREBY DECIDES AS FOLLOWS:**

**Article 1 :** A competitive entrance examination into year one of the Second cycle of the Higher Teacher Training College (ENS), University of Yaoundé I for the 2017/2018 academic year has been launched in the following series :

**Article 2 :** (1) The examination shall be organised in one sitting for Cameroonians of both sexes following the conditions stipulated below :

**- Section of student Teachers of Secondary General Education except the Computer Sciences and the English Modern Letters series**

Candidates should be holders of a Bachelor's Degree or Licence corresponding to the series opted for or any equivalent diploma recognised by the Minister of Higher Education.

**- Section of Computer Sciences**

➤ **Computer Science – Fundamental Computer Science Option**

Candidates should be holders of Bachelor's Degree or Licence in computer science, or any equivalent diploma recognised by the Minister of Higher Education

➤ **Computer Science –Information and Communication Technology Option**

Candidates should be holders of Bachelor's Degree or Licence in Arts and Letters, Bachelor's degree or Licence in Human sciences (History, Geography, psychology...), Bachelor's degree or Licence in Social sciences (Law, Economics, Management...), Bachelor's Degree or Licence in experimental sciences (Biology, Geology, Chemistry, Physics), Bachelor's Degree or Licence in Mathematics or any equivalent diploma recognised by the Minister of Higher Education

**- Section of English Modern Letters**

Candidates should be holders of Bachelor's Degree or Licence in English Modern Letters, Linguistics, African/English Literature or any equivalent diploma recognised by the Minister of Higher Education

**- Section of Guidance Counselling**

Candidates should be holders of a Bachelor's Degree or Licence in Science of Education, Economics, Social and Human Sciences, Law, Political Science or in Arts or any equivalent diploma recognised by the Minister of Higher Education.

**- Section of Teachers Trainers**

➤ Be holders of a Bachelor's Degree in Science of Education, Letters or in Human sciences.

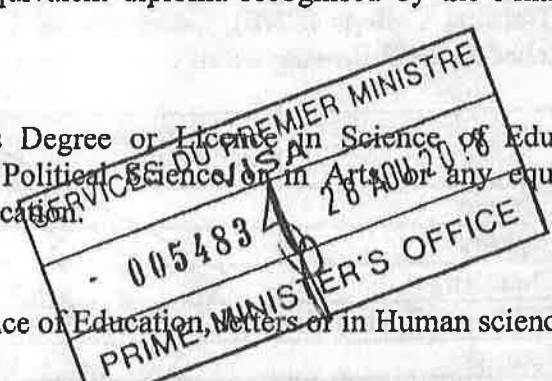
(2) Foreign candidates may be authorised to sit for the examination in the same academic conditions and according to the number of places available, in conformity with the regulations in force.

(3) Candidates must not be older than 32 years on January 1<sup>st</sup> 2017.

**Article 3 :** The application files shall comprise the following documents:

**- Section of student-teachers of Secondary General Education and Guidance Counselling**

- A registration form available at ENS, at each examination Centre, on the website of MINESUP <http://www.minesup.gov.cm> and on the website of ENS <http://www.ens.cm>



- A certified photocopy of birth certificate which must not be more than six (6) months old from the date of issue;
- Photocopies of transcripts of levels I, II, and III of Licence or Bachelor's Degree signed or certified by competent academic authorities;
- A certified photocopy of Licence or Bachelor's Degree or equivalent diploma which must not be more than six (6) months old from the date of issue ;
- A medical certificate issued by a medical officer, from the Administration, testifying that the candidate is physically and medically fit for teaching ;
- A certificate of non-conviction which must not be more than three (3) months old from the date of issue;
- A receipt upon payment of twenty thousand (20,000) CFA as registration fees delivered by BICEC account N° 100001-06865-95647265002-11. No other form of payment shall be accepted;
- One A4 self-addressed **machine-stamped** envelope;
- Two passport-size photographs;
- An authorisation to sit for the examination issued by the Minister of Basic Education, the Minister of Secondary Education or the Minister of Higher Education for civil servants working in these Ministries.

#### - Section of Teacher Trainers

- A registration form available at ENS, at each examination Centre, on the website of MINESUP <http://www.minesup.gov.cm> and on the website of ENS <http://www.ens.cm>
- A certified photocopy of birth certificate which must not be more than six (6) months old from the date of issue;
- Photocopies of transcripts of levels I, II, and III of Licence or Bachelor's Degree signed or certified by competent academic authorities;
- A certified photocopy of Licence or Bachelor's Degree or equivalent diploma which must not be more than six (6) months old from the date of issue ;
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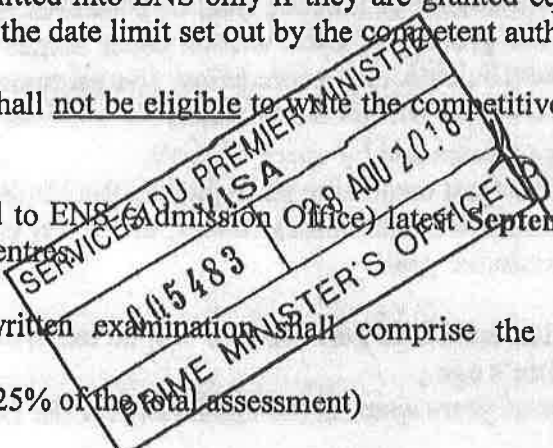
**Article 4:** Holders of foreign diplomas shall submit either a true copy of the ministerial order granting equivalence or the receipt showing that they have deposited an application for equivalence in the Ministry of Higher Education. These documents must be issued by the Minister of Higher Education. Such candidates can be finally admitted into ENS only if they are granted equivalence for their foreign diplomas or certificates within the date limit set out by the competent authority.

**Article 5 :** Candidates who are civil servants shall not be eligible to write the competitive entrance examination as external candidates.

**Article 6 :** Complete files should be submitted to ENS (Admission Office) latest **September 21<sup>st</sup>, 2018** and **September 14<sup>th</sup>, 2018** for Regional centres.

**Article 7 :** (1) The selection through a written examination shall comprise the following components:

- a) Academic performance (25% of the total assessment)



b) Two written papers (75% of the total assessment)

**Article 8** : The written examination for admission will take place on **Sunday, September 30<sup>rd</sup> 2018** in **Bafoussam, Buea, Douala, Ngaoundéré and Yaoundé**. The distribution of papers per series is indicated in the table below:

(1) The syllabuses of the competitive entrance examination which are the same as those of the Bachelor's Degree or Licence shall be published by ENS.

(2) The grading of each written paper ranges from zero to twenty according to the above-mentioned coefficients. Any score below five on twenty is eliminatory.

(3) After the written examination for admission, the jury shall prepare the list of successful candidates per series and by order of merit.

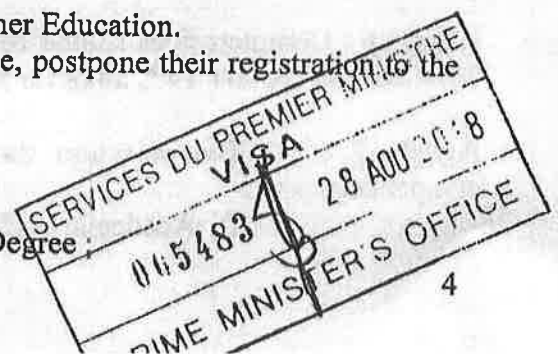
(4) The final results are published by the Minister of Higher Education.

(5) Successful candidates cannot, under any circumstance, postpone their registration to the following academic year.

**Article 9** : The academic performance will be based on :

- the candidate's age ;

- the number of years spent in the University for the Bachelor's Degree ;



- transcripts of levels I, II, and III of Licence or Bachelor's degree in the area of specialization and grades.


**Article 10:** The composition of the jury mentioned in article 7 above shall be specified by the Minister of Higher Education in conformity with the rules and regulations in force.

**Article 11 :** A fraudulent admission, within the non-respect of de conditions concerning diplomas, grade, age or seniority shall expose the concerned candidate to be excluded at any moment without any procedure.

**Article 12:** Registration fees are non refundable.

**Article 13:** The Rector of the University of Yaoundé I, the Director of the Department of University accreditations and quality, and the Director of the Higher Teacher Training College are responsible, each in his own domain, for the implementation of this circular which shall be registered and published in English and French wherever need be.
